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Instruction for Completion: The Learning Plan is a tool to guide the field practicum experience. While each student is expected to achieve the course objectives for the field practicum, each field experience is unique. Therefore, the Learning Plan should incorporate the field practicum's learning objectives in Micro, Mezzo and Macro, as well as the agency's goals and learning opportunities, and the student's individual learning goals and interests. If the agency or program does not have services available to help the student meet the learning objectives, other opportunities outside of the agency may be sought.

The Learning Plan is to be completed by field students, with the assistance of their Field Instructor (and On-Site Supervisor, when applicable). Students may include class assignments as a part of the identified tasks or activities. The student should make **three copies** of the learning plan to be available for: 1) The Director of Field Education 2) the Field Instructor's file; and 3) the Faculty Field Liaison's file. The plan must be completed in its entirety.

The Learning Plan should be used as part of the student's weekly supervision with the Field Instructor. Progress towards meeting objectives should be reviewed and used as an ongoing measure for the student evaluation process. The student will complete only that portion of the learning plan established for that semester. The plan is progressive and comprehensive. Field Instructor should initial and date each task activity completion.
