



CLEP

(aka College Level Exam Program®)

The College-Level Examination Program® or CLEP provides students of any age with the opportunity to demonstrate college-level achievement through a program of exams in undergraduate college courses. By receiving a satisfactory score, students can earn from 3 to 12 college credits toward a college degree for each CLEP exam taken, depending on the exam subject and the policy of the college or university.

- **Save time.** Get college credit for what you already know. Be rewarded for what you've learned through independent study, advanced high school courses, noncredit adult courses, or professional development.
- **Save money.** Compare the cost of a CLEP exam, just \$95, to hundreds — even thousands — of dollars in tuition. CLEP exams are free to military service members.
- **Make college more interesting.** Move right into advanced courses.
- Exams are available at Texas A&M in **34 college-level** courses. (*See back of this flyer for complete list*)
- CLEP is administered on computer and exams are **available year-round**.
- The tests are timed and **90 minutes long**.
- All exams are scored on a scale of 20 to 80.
- With the exception of English Composition with Essay, exams are composed primarily of multiple-choice questions. Some mathematics exams include fill-in type questions.
- Score reports are available immediately upon completion of the exam. Students know right away how they performed. (Scores for English Composition with Essay are available 2-3 weeks after the exam date).

Requirements: CLEP exams are available by appointment only. Appointments are scheduled from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Monday-Friday. Examinees must present: 1) Photo ID with signature (driver's license, or state issued ID card, or student ID w/ signature) and secondary ID 2) \$95 fee (\$70 payable to CLEP by check, money order or credit card and \$25 payable to TAMU-Commerce by cash or credit card.)
